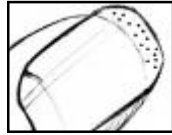


Nails and Hands

Before going to school:



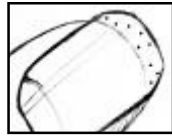
Paul has colonies of germs under his nails.

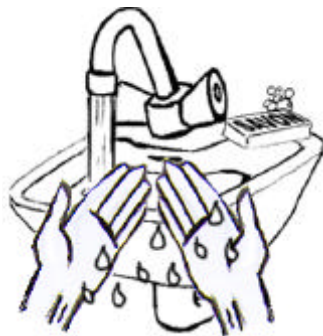

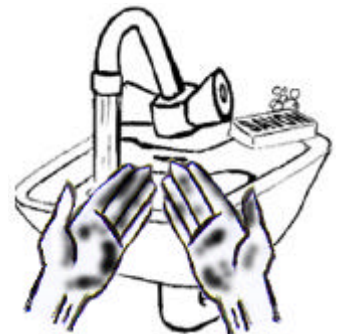
